In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the county of Rockingham, and now attending said Court at its October term, 1929, upon their oaths do present that Jacob Shipp on or about the 28th day of August, 1929, in the said county of Rockingham, did unlawfully and feloniously, ~~under promise of marriage,~~ seduce and have illicit connection with Stella Ruth Deeds, an unmarried female of previous chaste character, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.
