E. Liskey, in the said chickenhouse then and there being found, feloniously did steal, take, and carry away, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of H. E. Liskey, W. E. Lucas, and S. V. Shifflett, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
