CHARGE TO THE JURY

LEONARD LILLY

If you find the accused, Leonard Lilly, not guilty, you will say so and no more.

If you find him guilty of maliciously shooting steer, as charged in the indictment, then you will say so and fix his punishment by confinement in the penitentiary for not less than two nor more than ten years.

If you do not find him guilty of maliciously shooting, as charged in the indictment, but find him guilty of unlawful shooting, as charged therein, then you will say so and fix his punishment by confinement in jail for a period not exceeding twelve months, or by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

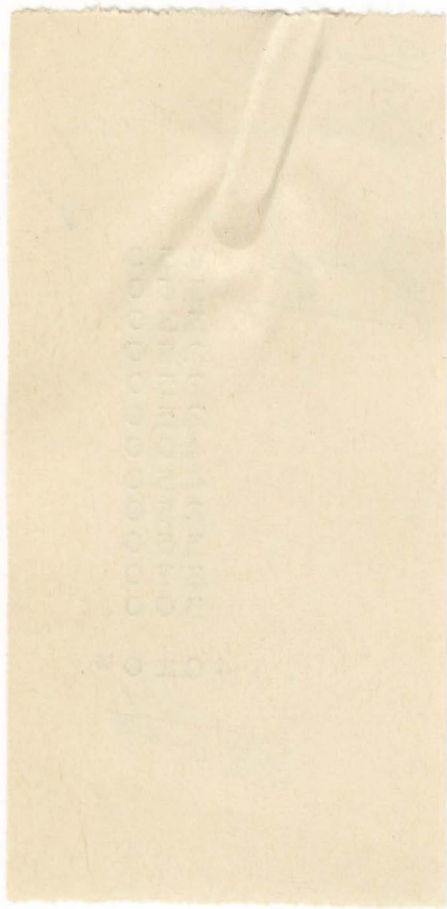

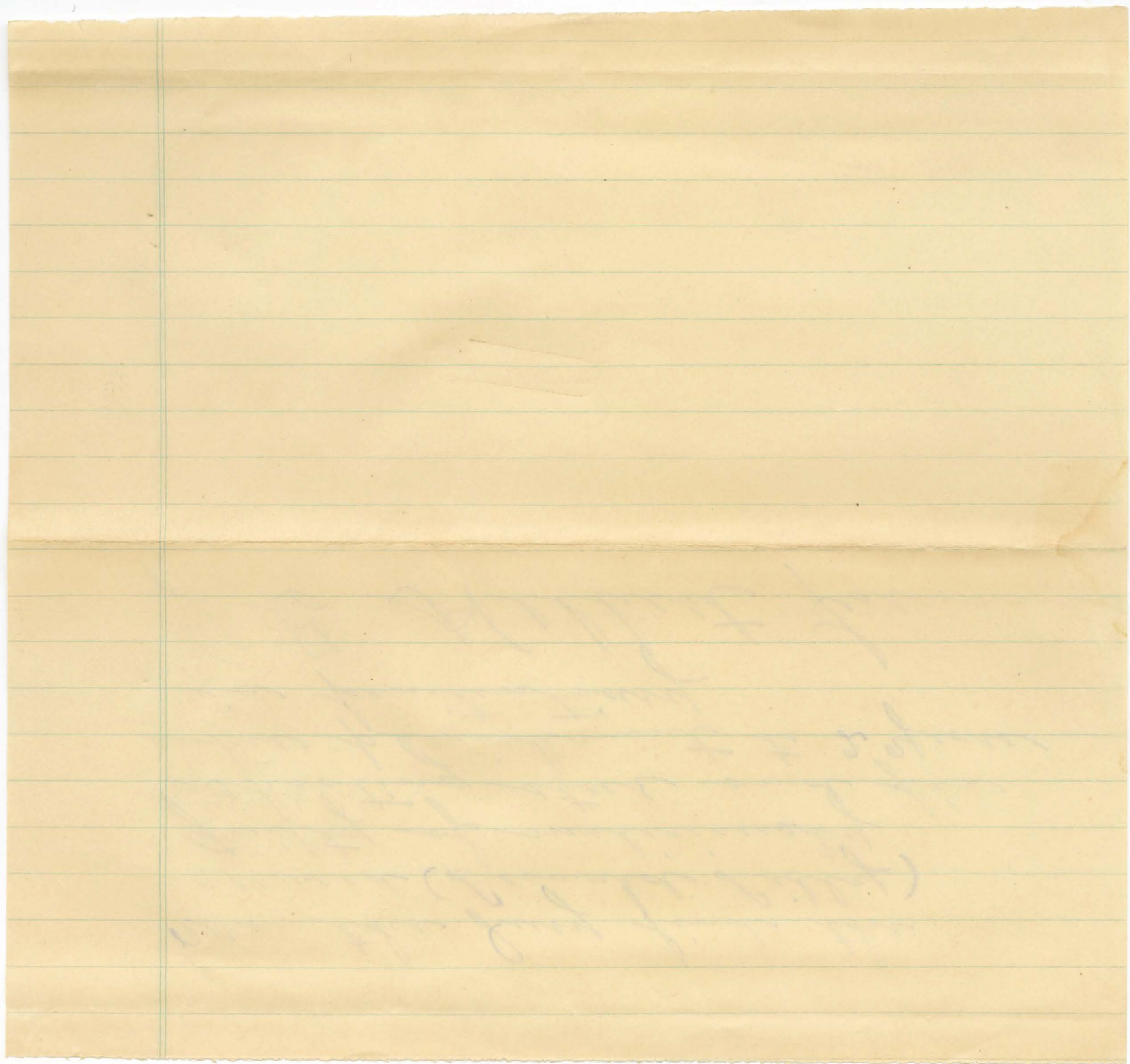
