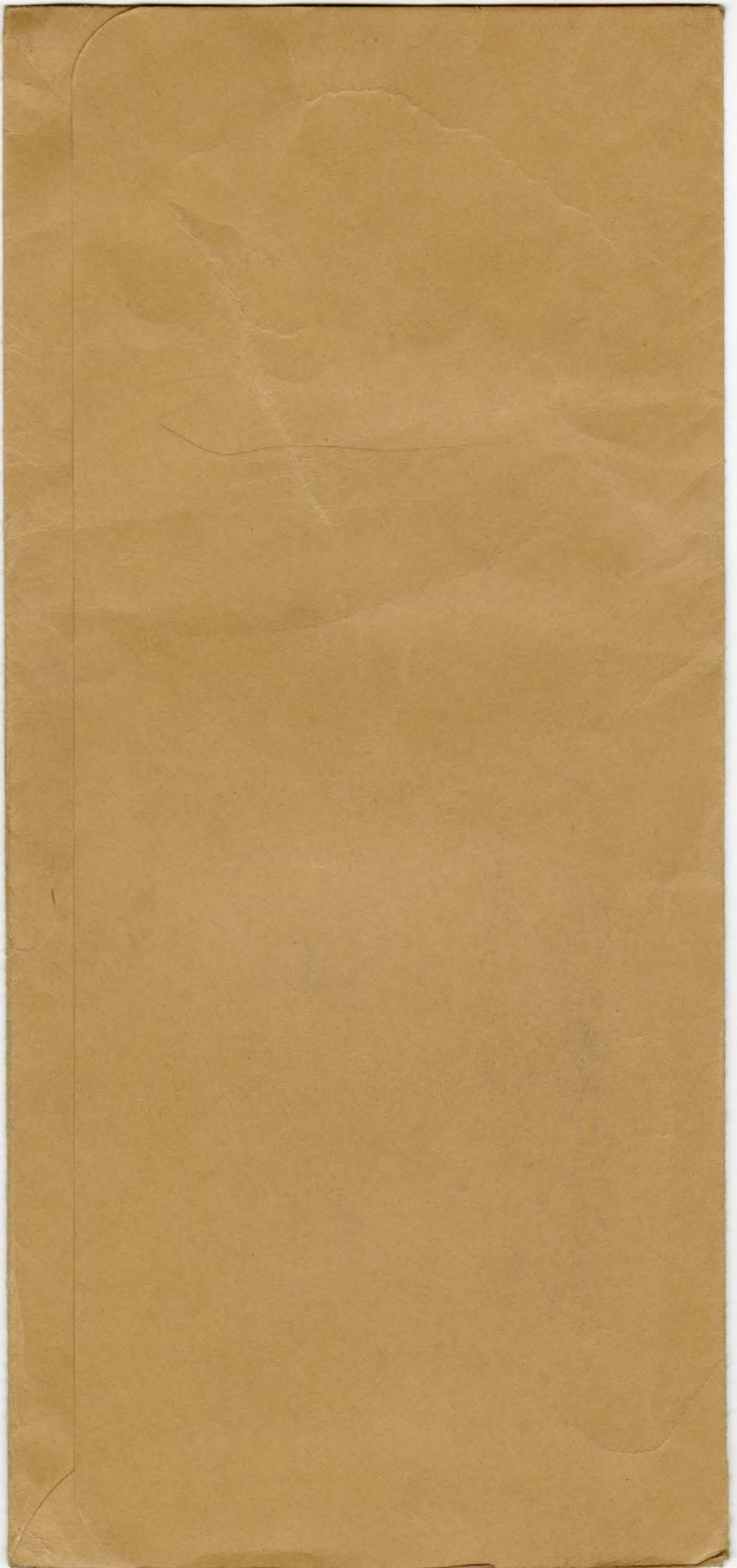

I, Sheppard L. J. J. or Bail Commissioner, in and for the County of Rockingham, State of Virginia, do hereby certify that Carlisle C. Long and Stutson Long

as his surety, have this day acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of Five Thousand dollars (\$ 5000.⁰⁰) as to which they severally waived their exemption, to be made and levied of their goods and chattels, yet upon this condition: That the said

Carlisle C. Long shall appear before the Trial Justice Court of Rockingham County at Harrisonburg, Va., on the 10th day of November, 1937, at 10 o'clock A. M., and not depart hence without leave of said Court, and at such other time or times to which the proceedings may be continued or further heard, and before any court or judge hereafter having or holding any proceedings in connection with said charge, and then and there answer the Commonwealth of Virginia concerning the within charge until the same is finally disposed of, then this recognizance shall be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia in and for the body of the county of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its December term, 1937, upon their oaths do present that Arlie C. Long did unlawfully, wrongfully, and fraudulently in said county, the time being to the grand jurors unknown, but between August 1, 1937 and November 6, 1937, use, dispose of, and convert to his own use and embezzle a large sum of money amounting in the aggregate to at least Seventeen Hundred Seven Dollars and Eleven Cents (\$1707.00), the property of the Valley of Virginia Milk Producers Association, a corporation, which said money was in his possession and was received by him in said county by virtue of his office, trust, and employment as cashier, head bookkeeper, and agent of said company in the course of his employment in the transaction of the business of said company, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

And the grand jurors aforesaid, upon their oaths aforesaid do further present that the said Arlie C. Long did unlawfully, wrongfully, and fraudulently, in said county, the time being to the grand jurors unknown, but between January 1, 1933 and November 6, 1937, use, dispose of, and convert to his own use and embezzle a large sum of money amounting in the aggregate to at least the sum of Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$10,900.00), the property of the Valley of Virginia Milk Producers Association, which said money was in his possession and was received by him in said county by virtue of his office, trust, and employment as cashier, head bookkeeper, and agent of said company in the course of his employment in the transaction of business of said company, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of David E. Shank and S. B. Hoover, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
