

COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

COUNTY OF ROCKINGHAM, to-wit:

In the Circuit Court of said County:

The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia in and for the body of said county of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its December term, 1930, upon their oaths do present that R. B. Ridgeway and W. H. Taylor were the agents and employees of The American Legion, Rockingham Post 27, Harrisonburg, Virginia, and as such employees and agents, had the custody of the funds of said Post, and did unlawfully, wrongfully, feloniously, and fraudulently, in said county, the time being unknown, but between June 7, 1930 and September 1, 1930, use, dispose of and convert to their own use and embezzle a large sum of money amounting in the aggregate to about two hundred thirty-eight dollars and twenty-five cents, the property of said American Legion, Rockingham Post 27, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of E. L. Klingstein, Fred Koontz, and W. Glen Elliott, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
