This day came the attorney for the commonwealth, and the accused, Mutt Riggleman, came pursuant to his recognizance and by his attorneys, R. S. Wright, Jr., and F. H. Bumback. And thereupon, said accused, in person and by counsel, and with the consent of the court and the attorney for the commonwealth, waived trial by jury and agreed to submit all matters of law and fact to the court for hearing and decision, and the court, ~~with the consent of the attorney for the commonwealth,~~ proceeded to hear and determine this case without the intervention of a jury. Having heard the evidence, the court doth find said accused, Mutt Riggleman, guilty of assault and battery as charged in the indictment, and doth fix his punishment at ~~xxfinexxofx~~ ~~Onexhundreddollarsxx~~ six months in jail and a fine of one hundred dollars. And it being inquired of the prisoner if anything he had or knew to say why the court should not pronounce sentence on him and nothing being offered or alleged in delay thereof, it is therefore considered by the court that the commonwealth recover of the said Mutt Riggleman one hundred dollars, the fine aforesaid, and the costs incident to this prosecution, and that he be held to hard labor on the State Convict Road Force for the term of six (6) months and thereafter until said fine and costs are paid. However, it appearing to be compatible with the public interest so to do, execution of said sentence is hereby suspended and the said Mutt Riggleman is placed on probation in the care and custody of the Probation Officer for this District, said suspension of sentence and probation being conditioned upon his good behavior in all respects for a period of one year and observing such rules and regulations as may from time to time be established or required by said Parole Board during the term of such suspension.

Thereupon, the said Mutt Riggleman, ~~entered into xxxxxx~~ and Albert B. Coby as his surety, who justified as to his sufficiency, ~~entered into and~~ acknowledged ~~bound in the penalty of xFive Hundred Dollars, x(\$500.00),~~ themselves, jointly and severally, bound to the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, (\$500.00), waiving the benefit of their homestead exemption as to said obligation, said bond


