

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE *19th* day of *March* in the year of our Lord 1832 Between *Michael*
J. H. Harris one of the Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Saech Shawer* of
the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the *day of January*
in the year 1832 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Walter Lewis* of the age of *Fifteen* years
to be an Apprentice with him the said *Saech Shawer* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Saech Shawer* to dwell from the
date of these presents, until the said *Walter Lewis* shall arrive, and come to the age of *twenty one* years, according to the Act of the General
Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Walter Lewis* shall the said *Saech Shawer*
well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Walter Lewis* shall be put unto by his said *Master*
according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Walter Lewis* and the said *Walter Lewis* honestly and obediently in all things be-
have towards the said *Saech Shawer* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Saech Shawer* And the
said *Saech Shawer* for himself Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the
Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *Blacksmithing* which
he the said *Saech Shawer* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and
informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Saech Shawer* shall also find and allow unto the said
Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said
Saech Shawer shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *Walter Lewis* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the
Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Walter Lewis* the Sum of *twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
