

This Indenture Witnesseth that I, John Krötzer overseer of the poor for the parish
and County of Rockingham by an order of the Court of the said County made at
Septentur last to me a Justice hath and by these presents doth put and bind Mary Helbert
Daughter of Barnet Helbert of the age of 6 years the 23 of July 1804 an apprentice to
Daniel Shawalter of the said County to serve him as an apprentice untill she shall
arrive to the age of Eighteen years, during which term the said apprentice her said
master faithfully shall serve his secrets his lawful commands obey she shall do no
Damage to her said master nor wilfully suffer it to be done by others and shall in ^{all} other
other respects obey her said master during the term aforesaid.

In consideration whereof the said master shall provide and procure sufficient
meal drink washing and clothing fitting for such apprentice during the said term
and teach the said apprentice to read the bible and write tolerably well and learn
her or cause to be learned to knit sew and spin and at the expiration of the said term
to pay or cause to be paid her twelve Dollars ^{if given her} for a bed and spinning wheel the person
does allanied by Law. In Witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their
