That on May 27th, 1923, S. F. Newman, E. J. Dillard, and
C. D. Fulk, Deputy Sheriffs for Rockingham County, did on a public
road in the Blue Ridge Mountains southeast of Port Republic in
Rockingham County, Virginia, seize a Ford touring car, model
1916, engine number 1256972, (there being no license tag on
