The jurors of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in and for the body of the County of Rockingham, and now attending the Circuit Court of said county, ^{at its October term, 1919,} UPON THEIR OATHS' PRESENT, that James H. Crawford, Jr., W.M. Shifflett and Victoria Davis, within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in said County, did unlawfully manufacture, sell, offer, keep, store and expose for sale, give away, transport, dispense, solicit, advertise and receive orders for ardent spirits,

against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

AND THE JURORS AFORESAID, UPON THEIR OATHS AFORESAID, DO FURTHER PRESENT, that James H. Crawford, Jr., W.M. Shifflett and Victoria Davis, within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in said County, did unlawfully keep and store ardent spirits in places other than their homes,

against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of W. E. Lucas

witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the Grand Jury to give evidence.

Whereas On information has this day made complaint and information on oath before me L. V. Bruce Mayor of said Town, that James Crawford of the said Town, on the 17 day of Sept - 1909 in said Town, did unlawfully transport excise spirits in the town

These are, therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me or some other Justice the body of said James Crawford to answer the said complaint and to be further dealt with according to law.
