

This Indenture made this Tenth day of July 1819 between
Stephen Harusberger Overseer of the Poor of the County of Rock-
ingham of the one part & Thomas Frame of the said County of the
other part. Witnesseth that the sd. Stephen Harusberger overseer
of the poor as aforesaid, by virtue of an order of the aforesaid
County bearing date "September Court 1818. have put placed
and bound and by these presents doth put place and bind Jacob
Pool orphan of Rice Pool of the age of 12 years the 10th day of Decr:
1818. to dwell from this date until the said Jacob Pool shall
come to the age of 21 years according to the act of the General
assembly in that case provided. during which term of time
the said Jacob Pool shall well & faithfully serve the said Frame
and shall honestly & obediently behave himself towards the rest
of the family of the said Tho. Frame, who on his part doth for him-
self and his Executor & Administrators promise & covenant with
aforesaid Overseer of the Poor & his successors & successors for the time
being to & with the said Jacob Pool have him taught the Craft &
art of Tanning & Currying & all that thereunto belongeth after
the best manner he can be taught, And that the sd. Thomas
Frame shall find & allow him sufficient meat, drink, apparel
washing lodging & all other things needful for him during his
the said term of time aforesaid, And also that the said Thomas
Frame shall Cause to be taught to the said Jacob
Pool reading writing & Arithmetic including the

the single Rule of three, and will moreover pay to the ^{sd} Jacob
Pool the sum of Twenty Dollars at the expiration of the afore^{sd}
