And more over he is to find the said Sarah in good sufficient bloathing, Meat, Drink, washing and lodging during the said term fit and convenient for such an Appointie. And at the end of her Service shall pay and satisfy to the said Farah Stout a Bed and furniture, with an extra suit of bloathes the whole to be worth thirty five Dollars being the freedom dues allowed by the In witness where of the said Overseer hath of the Poor afores ow hath hererento set his hand eseal, and the said Huddle hath hereunto set his hand I Seal the day above written.
