

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE *Third* day of *November*

in the year of our Lord 18 *24* Between *George Whempus* Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *George W Burton*

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid

baring date the *second* day of *November* in the year *above mentioned*

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Isaac McClary* of the age

of *sixteen years* ^{*six months*} years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *George W Burton*

and as an Apprentice with him the said *George W Burton* to dwell from the date of these presents,

until the said *Isaac McClary* shall arrive and come to the age of *Twenty one*

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said

Isaac McClary shall the said *George W Burton* his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Isaac McClary*

shall be put unto by *George W Burton* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *him*

the said *Isaac McClary* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards *him*

said *George W Burton* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said *George W Burton* And the said *George W Burton*

for himself, *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Sailor*

which he the said *George W Burton* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that

he the said *George W Burton* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that

the said *George W Burton* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Isaac McClary*

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Isaac*

McClary the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year
