




This Indenture made this 15th day of March in the Year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred & twenty Seven between John H. Effinger & James Cootes - of the one part and Peter Trick of the Town of Harrisonburg of the other part (Witnesseth) That the sd John H. Effinger & James Cootes - Overseers of the poor as aforesaid by virtue of an order of the County Court of Rockingham bearing date March Court - 1827 have put, placed & bound & by these presents do put, place & bind Robert May (son of Patsy May) ~~aged~~ 12 years to be an apprentice with him the said Peter Trick to dwell from the date of these presents until the said Robert May shall fully arrive to the age of Twenty-One years, according to the act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. By and during all such time & term, the sd Robert May shall the said Peter Trick his Master well & faithfully serve in all such lawful business as the said Peter Trick shall put him to according to the wit power & ability of him the said Robert May and honestly & obediently in all things shall behave himself so as his said Master, and honestly and orderly towards the family of the sd Peter Trick.

And the said Peter Trick for his part for himself, his Executors, Administrators & assigns, doth hereby promise & covenant, to and with the said Overseers of the Poor, and every of them, and every of their Executors, and Administrators, and this & every of their successors for the time being, and to & with the said Robert May, that he the said Peter Trick shall the said Robert May teach or cause to be taught, the trade & mystery of a Saddle tree Maker, and that the said Peter Trick shall also find and allow to the said Apprentice sufficient, Meat, drink, apparel, lodging, & Washing, & all other things, necessary and meet for an apprentice, during the aforesaid term, and moreover pay to the said Robert May as freedom dues Twenty Dollars at the expiration of his aforesaid term, In Witness whereof the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands & seals the day and year first above written
