

# THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE *Third* day of *January* in the year of our Lord 1838 Between *John H. Effinger* one of the Overseer of the Poor of the \_\_\_\_\_ District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *George W. Sanford* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the *20th* day of *September* in the year 1835 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Ephraim (Alias) Emsey Williamson* of the age of *Seven* years to be an Apprentice with him the said *George W. Sanford* and as an Apprentice with him the said *George W. Sanford* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Emsey Williamson* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Eightteen* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *Emsey Williamson* shall the said *George W. Sanford* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Emsey Williamson* shall be put unto by ~~his~~ said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Emsey Williamson* and the said *Emsey Williamson* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *George W. Sanford* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *George W. Sanford* And the said *George W. Sanford* for himself ~~his~~ Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *House Keeping* which he the said *George W. Sanford* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *George W. Sanford* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the the term aforesaid: ~~And also that the said~~ ~~shall teach, or cause to be taught to the~~ ~~Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three~~ and will moreover pay to the said *Emsey Williamson* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
