

This Indenture made the twenty third Day of July in  
year of our low one thousand eight hundred and thirteen between  
John Sellars overseer of the poor of the County of Rockingham  
of the one part and Jacob Whiting of the Said County  
of the other part Witnesseth, that the Said John Sellars  
overseer of the poor as afore Said, hath in Conformity to  
an order of the Court of the afore Said County Dated  
March Court 1813 hath put place and bound and by  
these presents Do put place and bind Sally Glasp a poor  
Gul whose parents are not able to Support to Jacob Whiting  
the Said Sally Glasp being eight years old the 31<sup>st</sup> Day of  
January last to Dwell with him the Said Jacob Whiting  
from the Date of these presents untill she attainz the  
age of Eighteen <sup>years</sup> according to the act of assembly in that  
case made (and provided), and During all which time the  
the Said Sally Glasp shall the Said Jacob Whiting her master  
well and truly Serve in all such lawful business as the  
Sally Glasp shall be put unto by her Said master, according  
to the power, wit. and ability of her the Said Sally Glasp,  
(and honestly and obediently in all things shall behave herself  
towards her master, and honestly and obediently towards the  
family of her Said master, and the Said Jacob Whiting)  
shall also find and allow unto her the Said Sally Glasp  
sufficient meat drink washing lodging and apparel, and all  
things necessary for an apprentice During the Said term  
(as afore Said, and also shall teach or cause to be taught the Said  
Sally Glasp reading and writings) and more <sup>over</sup> shall pay  
unto the Said Sally Glasp at the expiration of her term  
the Sum of twenty Dollars — In witness where of the  
parties have here unto Set their hands and Seal the  
Day and year first above written —
