Whereas John R. Logan has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, JOHN W. MORRISON, Mayor of said City, that Charles Cook, who was heretofore, to-wit, on the 21st day of March, 1932, in the Federal Court at Harrisonburg, Va., convicted of violating the prohibition laws, and given ^{one} ~~sixty~~ days in jail, on the 3d day of November, 1932, unlawfully and feloniously ^{did} sell about one pint of ardent spirits,

in violation of an ordinance of the said city:

These are therefore in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice, the body of the said
