

This Indenture MADE THE 19th day of August

in the year of our Lord 1839 Between James Davis

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the 3rd District District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and Susan Melloby of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the 19th day of August in the year 1839 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Susan Melloby of the age of 14

years to be an Apprentice with him the said William Dunlap and as an Apprentice with him the said William Dunlap to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Susan Melloby shall arrive, and come to the age of eighteen years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said

Susan Melloby shall the said William Dunlap well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Susan Melloby shall be put unto by her said Master according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said Susan Melloby and the said Susan Melloby honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said William Dunlap

John W Dunlap and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said William Dunlap And the said William Dunlap for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby

promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a housekeeper which he the said

John W William Dunlap now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

John W William Dunlap shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

John W William Dunlap shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said Susan Melloby Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Susan Melloby the Sum of twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
