baring date the 1st day of January in the year 1827

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Elizabeth Berry of the age

of 14 years the 19th Janry years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Fredrick Hains

and as an Apprentice with him the said Fredrick Hains to dwell from the date of these presents,

until the said she said Elizabeth Berry shall arrive and come to the age of Eighteen

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Weaver's

which he the said Fredrick Hains now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that

he the said Fredrick Hains shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that

the said Fredrick Hains shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Elizabeth Berry

Reading, Writing, and ~~Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three~~, and will moreover pay to the said Elizabeth

Berry the Sum of Ten Dollars at the Expiration of the
