ingham County, but, as to his claim in connection with Tract No.53-a,



he has not submitted this claim to arbitration, and, as this land lies outside of the Kelsey line, he has been informed that the same will not be taken. He here requests that this suit be dismissed as to Tract No. 53-a.

That Annie R. Begoon has submitted her claim to arbitration, and that this case will be heard before the Arbitration Board sitting in Rockingham County.

That J.W. Hinkle has submitted his claim to arbitration, and that this case will be heard before the Arbitration Board sitting in Rockingham County.

That Herbert G. Patterson and Herbert G. Patterson, Howard H. Patterson, and David H. Patterson, have submitted their several claims to arbitration, but, as the greater portion of their lands lies in Albemarle County, their cases will be heard before the Arbitration Board sitting in that County.

That your respondents, R.O. Nizer, C.G. Harnsberger, John A. Hensley, Luther J. Strickler, J.O. Harnsberger, Sarah L. Upp, W.T. Herring, and J.H. Lewin, are informed, believe, and aver that all of their respective lands or mineral interests lie outside of the Kelsey line and will not be taken for Park purposes at this time, and your respondents therefore pray that an order may be entered in this matter dismissing the pending suit as to them.
