MADE THE *9th* day of *September* in the year of our Lord 1851 Between *Jacob Rohr Sr.*

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and *Alexander M. Gilroy* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County Court made at *August*

Court in the year 1851 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Gerrard Spencer* of the age of *6 years on the 17th Nov. 1847* to be an Apprentice with him the said *Alex. M. Gilroy* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Alex. M. Gilroy* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Gerrard Spencer* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Twenty one* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *Gerrard Spencer* shall the said

Alex. M. Gilroy well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Gerrard Spencer* shall be put unto by the said *A. M. Gilroy* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Gerrard Spencer* and the said

Gerrard Spencer honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Alex. M. Gilroy* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Alex. M. Gilroy* And the said *Alex. M. Gilroy* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall be instructed in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *Farming* which he the said

now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said *Alex. M. Gilroy*


shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said


~~shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said~~ *Reading, Writing and Common Arithme*

~~tic including the Rule of Three~~, and will moreover pay to the *Mother of said boy* the sum of *Two dollars per year commencing with the 9th of September, 1851, untill the said boy arrives at the age of twenty one years*
