

This Indenture MADE THE *first* day of *June*

in the year of our Lord 1844 Between *Jacob Pohn Sr.*

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and
James Caynor of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of
an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date ~~the~~ *May last* day of ~~the~~ in the year 1844 has
placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Souisa Freeborn* of the age of *fourteen*
years to be an Apprentice with him the said *James Caynor* and as an Apprentice
with him the said *James Caynor* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said
Souisa Freeborn shall arrive, and come to the age of *Eighteen* years, according
to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said
Souisa Freeborn shall the said *James Caynor*
well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Souisa Freeborn* shall be put unto
by ~~the~~ said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Souisa Freeborn* and
the said *Souisa Freeborn* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *James*
Caynor and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *James Caynor*
And the said *James Caynor* for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby
promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said
Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *House work* ~~which he the said~~

~~not use~~, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,
or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said
James Caynor shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel,
washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: ~~And also that the said~~

~~shall teach, or cause to be taught to the~~
~~Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetick including the Rule of Three,~~ and will moreover pay to the said *Souisa*
Freeborn the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
