In the Circuit Court of said County:

The grand jurors in and for the body of said County of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its April term, 1923, upon their oaths do present that Thomas Stogsdill within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in the said County of Rockingham, did unlawfully manufacture, sell, offer, keep, store and expose for sale, give away, transport, dispense, solicit, advertise and receive orders for ardent spirits, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The jurors aforesaid upon their oaths aforesaid do further present that Thomas Stogsdill within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment in the said County of Rockingham did unlawfully have in his possession a still, still cap, worm, tub, fermenter, and other appliances connected with and used in the operation of a still, without having the same registered as required by law, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of W.T. Rexrode, C.D. Fulk, and ~~E. J. Dillard~~, witnesses sworn in court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
