In consideration of which the said Rife binds himself to the said Brenner or his Successor Overseer of the Poor to teach or instruct or cause to be laught or instructed the said Lydia Althony the Business of housewifery. That is to say he is to teach her to learn her to read correctly, and corite a good fair hand during said term. And moreover to Jurnish said Lydia in good sufficient Cloathing, Meat, Drink, Washing and Lodging Lit and convenient for such an Apprentice. And also at the end of her Service shall pay Isatisfy to the said Lydia Melbenry twenty Dollars for freedom dues as the Law directs.
