of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the *First* day of *August* in the year *1825*

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Abigail Eaton* of the age of *Twelve* years, to be an Apprentice with him the said *Daniel Dovel*

and as an Apprentice with him the said *Daniel Dovel* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Abigail Eaton* shall arrive and come to the age of *Eighteen*

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said *Abigail Eaton* shall the said *Daniel Dovel* her ~~his~~ said *Master*

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Abigail Eaton* shall be put unto by *Said Daniel Dovel* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of *her the said Abigail Eaton*

of the said *Daniel Dovel* And the said *Daniel Dovel* for himself Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *house keeping*

which he the said *Daniel Dovel* now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Daniel Dovel* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said *Daniel Dovel* shall teach or cause to be taught to the said *Abigail Eaton*

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetick including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Abigail Eaton* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the
