And the jurors aforesaid upon their oaths aforesaid do further present that Jude M. Comer, who was heretofore on May 18, 1923, convicted of violating the Prohibition laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the Circuit Court of said Rockingham County, and who then and there was sentenced to pay a fine of one hundred ninety dollars and serve for a period of three months in jail, did, within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in the said county of Rockingham, unlawfully and feloniously have in his possession ardent spirits, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia each in the sum of
Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars, (\$ 750.00),

to be levied of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements, for the use of the Common-
wealth of Virginia rendered, and they each severally waived their homestead exemption to their re-
cognizance; yet upon this condition:

That if the said J M Comer shall personally appear before
the Circuit Court of Rockingham County, at the Courthouse of said County, on the 1st day of the
April - 1930 Term thereof, being the 21st day of April,
1930, and at such other time or times to which the proceedings may be continued or further

heard, and before any court or judge hereafter having or holding any proceedings in connection with
the said charge, and then and there answer the Commonwealth of Virginia concerning a certain
misdemeanor whereof the said J M Comer stands

charged, and be bound under said recognizance until the charge is finally disposed of or until it is
declared void by order of a competent court, then the above recognizance shall be null and void; other-
wise to remain in full force and effect.
