Mystery and Occupation of a Blacksmith $\qquad$ which he the said Deter-Aturclaugh now useth, after the bet manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth and that he the said Peter flumbough shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said Beter-Atumbaugh shall teach, or cause to be taught to the si ferry, Butter- Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Cheney 3 utter the sum of Seventy Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid ter,
