



**THIS INDENTURE** MADE THE *2<sup>nd</sup>* day of *March* in the year of our Lord 1829 Between *John Bowman*  
one of the Overseer of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Henry Beary* of  
the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date ~~the~~ *December* ~~day~~ of *Count*  
in the year 1829 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Jacob Vance* of the age of *nine* years  
to be an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Beary* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Beary* to dwell from the  
date of these presents, until the said *Jacob Vance* shall arrive, and come to the age of *twentyone* years, according to the Act of the General  
Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Jacob Vance* shall the said *Henry Beary*  
well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Jacob Vance* shall be put unto by his said *Master*  
according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Jacob Vance* and the said *Jacob Vance* honestly and obediently in all things be-  
have towards the said *Henry Beary* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Henry Beary* And the  
said *Henry Beary* for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the  
Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *a Farmer* which  
he the said *Henry Beary* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and  
informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Henry Beary* shall also find and allow unto the said  
Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said  
*Henry Beary* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *Jacob Vance* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the  
Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Jacob Vance* the Sum of *twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term,  
IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangeably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
