

This Indenture made this first day of January one  
eight hundred's  
Thousand, and seven between John Baxter overseer of poor  
for the south District in the County of Rockingham of the  
one part and Josiah Harrison of said County of the other  
part witnesseth that the said overseer of the poor in per-  
suance of an order of Court of the said County bearing date  
at November one thousand eight hundred and five doth put  
place and bind Elizabeth Miller a poor girl of said County  
being Ten years old: the first of July eighteen hundred and  
six unto the said Josiah Harrison to dwell with and  
serve him untill she shall arrive at the age of Eighteen

In consideration whereof the said Josiah Harrison  
doth bind himself to the said John Baxter or his Success-  
or Overseer of the poor to furnish said girl with cloths  
Meat Drink and lodging fit and convenient, and to  
teach or cause to be taught said girl to read and write  
~~and to furnish her with~~ ~~including the value of three~~  
and at the end of her servitude to furnish her with  
all such freedom Dues as the Law directs  
in witness whereof each of us has hereunto set our  
hands and seals the day and year above written
