The Special Investigators and Board of Appraisal
Commissioners on this 17th day of May, 1932, submitted to the Court their
report as required by Section 4388 (31) of the Code of Virginia, of 1930,
together with the map and other exhibits referred to and made of said report;
and it appearing to the Court that said report is in proper form and is
responsive to the order of the Court submitting to said Board the matters
required by the Statute to be so submitted, the Court, pursuant to Section
4388 (32) of the Code of Virginia of 1930, endorses upon said report an order
in the following words, to-wit: "To the Board of Appraisal Commissioners for
Rappahannock County, Virginia;

This report shall be held in the custody of George
H. Levi, one of the members of said Board until the 18th day of May, 1932,
and on said 18th day of May, 1932, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, the
said George H. Levi shall file said report together with the map and all other
exhibits therein referred to and made a part thereof, with the record of
this case in the office of the Clerk of this Court."
