has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Sally Stuart A poor girl ~~of the age~~ ^{day of May 1822} ~~31 years~~ to be an Apprentice with him the said John Gunn

and as an Apprentice with him the said John Gunn to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Sally Stuart shall arrive and come to the age of Eighteen

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said Sally Stuart shall the said John Gunn ~~his~~ said

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said John Gunn shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient


meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said John Gunn shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Sally Stuart


