

This Indenture made the 17<sup>th</sup> day of Decr in the year 1816 between  
Aaron Solomon & Rich<sup>d</sup> Fletcher overseers of the poor  
in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Henry Puttz of the  
Same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Overseer of  
the poor in pursuance of an order of the County Court of Rocking-  
-ham made at June Court 1816 do put and bind <sup>Christian</sup> George (free  
boy of colour) Six years old the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1816 also George  
(a free boy of colour) three years old the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February last as  
apprentices to him the said Henry Puttz and with him after the  
manner of apprentices to dwell and serve untill each of them  
shall arrive to the age of Twenty one years. In consideration of  
which the said Henry Puttz binds himself to the said Solomon  
& Fletcher — or their successors in office to find the said appren-  
-tises in good and sufficient clothes meat drink and Lodging  
fit and convenient for each apprentices and also at the end  
of their said apprenticeship shall pay or cause to be paid to  
each of said apprentices the Sum of Twenty Dollars. In Witness  
whereof the said Aaron Solomon & R<sup>ch</sup> Fletcher and Henry Puttz  
have hereunto set their hands and Seals the day and year
