

This Indenture MADE THE 27th day of May

in the year of our Lord 1848 Between *Jacob Rohr Sr.*

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and

Henry Pulse Sr. of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the *May* *second* day of *May* in the year 1848 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *John Wean* of the age of *eight* years to be an Apprentice with him the said *Henry Pulse Sr.* and as an Apprentice

with him the said *Henry Pulse Sr.* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *John Wean* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Twenty One* years, according

to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said *John Wean* shall the said *Henry Pulse Sr.*

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *John Wean* shall be put unto by his said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *John Wean* and

the said *John Wean* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Henry Pulse Sr.* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Henry Pulse Sr.*

And the said *Henry Pulse Sr.* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, (that the said

Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a *Farmer* which he the said *Henry Pulse Sr.*

now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

Henry Pulse Sr. shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

Henry Pulse Sr. shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *John Wean* Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *John Wean*

a *suit of clothes* the Sum of *Twelve* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
