The grand jurors in and for the body of said county of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its February term, 1930, upon their oaths do present that George Dean, who was heretofore on the 20th day of April, 1923, convicted of violating the Prohibition laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the Circuit Court of said Rockingham County, and who then and there was sentenced to pay a fine of three hundred dollars and serve for a period of five months in jail, did, within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in the said county of Rockingham, unlawfully and feloniously receive and have in his possession ardent spirits, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of C. R. Fawley, Mrs. C. R. Fawley, J. L. Dirting, and Captain Dinges, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
