

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 17 day of May in the year of our Lord 1828 Between Michael

Harris one of the Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Jno Whitmore of

the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the day of May

in the year 1828 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind David Gladwell of the age of eight ~~not eight~~ years ~~next~~

Sept to be an Apprentice with him the said Jno Whitmore and as an Apprentice with him the said Jno Whitmore to dwell from the

date of these presents, until the said David Gladwell shall arrive, and come to the age of 31 years, according to the Act of the General

Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said David Gladwell shall the said Jno Whitmore

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said David Gladwell shall be put unto by his said Master

according to the Power Wit and Ability of the said David Gladwell and the said D Gladwell honestly and obediently in all things be-

have towards the said J Whitmore and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said J Whitmore And the

said J Whitmore for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the

Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of Husbandry which

he the said Jno Whitmore now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and

informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Jno Whitmore shall also find and allow unto the said

Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

J Whitmore shall teach, or cause to be taught to the David Gladwell Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the

Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said D Gladwell the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
