

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE *fifth* day of *November* in the year of our Lord 1827 Between *John Bowman* one of the Overseer of the Poor of the *first* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and *Christian Kemmery* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overeer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date the *January 11th of March last* in the year 1827 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Christian Gowl* of the age of *fifteen* years to be an Apprentice with him the said *Christian Kemmery* and as an Apprentice with him the said *Christian Kemmery* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said *Christian Gowl* shall arrive, and come to the age of *twentyone* years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Christian Gowl* shall the said *Christian Kemmery* well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Christian Gowl* shall be put unto by his said *Master* according to the Power Wit and Ability of the said *Christian Gowl* and the said *Christian Gowl* honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Christian Kemmery* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Christian Kemmery* And the said *Christian Kemmery* for himself *his* Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *House Joiner* which he the said *Christian Kemmery* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Christian Kemmery* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said *Christian Kemmery* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the *Christian Gowl* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Christian Gowl* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
