

This Indenture made the 3^d day of April in the year 1827
Between John H. Effinger Overseer of the Poor of the District in
the County of Rockingham of the one part and Daniel Piper of the other
part Witnesseth that the Said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by Virtue
of an order of the Court aforesaid bearing date the 3^d day of April 1827
has placed and Bound and by these presents doth place and bind
Manuvy Good (a Coloured Child of the age of who was formerly
Bound to Henry Dooy of the Age of Seven years at Christmas next
to be an Apprentice with him the Said Daniel Piper as an Appre-
ntice with him the Said Daniel Piper to Dwell from the date of these
presents untill the Said Manuvy Good shall arrive and come to the
Age of Eighteen years according to the Act of the General Assembly
in that case made and provided by and during all which time
and term the Said Manuvy Good shall the Said Daniel Piper her
Said Master well and faithfully serve in all such Lawful business as
the Said Daniel Piper Manuvy Good shall be put unto by her Said
Master according to the power Wit and ability of her the Said
Manuvy Good and the Said Manuvy Good constantly and Obedi-
ently in all things behave towards her Said Master Daniel
Piper and constantly and orderly towards the rest of the Family
of the Said Daniel Piper And the Said Daniel Piper for himself his Executors
and Admors doth hereby promise and Covenant to and with the
Said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being that the
Said Apprentice shall be taught the Art of House Work Spining &c
after the best manner that he can or may teach instruct and info-
rm or cause to be taught instructed and informed as much as
thrusts belongeth or in anywise appertaineth and that the Said
Daniel Piper shall also find and allow unto the Said apprentice
Sufficient Meat Drink Apparel Washing Lodging and all other thing
needfull or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid and
also that the Said Daniel Piper will moreover pay to Said Manuvy
Good the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the expiration of the aforesaid term
