Gentlemen:

I am returning the papers in the petition of Cora A. Green and others for the distribution of a fund in Page County for tract No. 304.

In reading the petition I find that in the paragraph at the top of page 3 it is stated that the heirs of W. H. Fray and the other two estates are willing that the sums be paid into the hands of the various executors. This carries with it an implication that possibly the executors are not empowered by the several wills to receive this fund. If this is the case the heirs-at-law should either join in the petition or file an answer, or in some way appear in the case so that the record will disclose proper consent.

I would suggest that you file with the petition copies of the three several wills so that I can act intelligently in entering the order for distribution.
