

VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF ROCKINGHAM COUNTY

The State Commission on Conservation and Development  
of the State of Virginia - - - - - Petitioner.

V. AT LAW NO. 1829

Cassandra Lawson Atkins and others and Fifty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-One (52,561) Acres of Land, more or less, in Rockingham County, Virginia - - - - - Defendants.

This day came counsel for the Petitioner in the above entitled proceeding and exhibited the record therein including the Judgments in Rem entered therein respectively the 4th day of November 1933, and the 28th day of February 1934; and the orders entered therein respectively the 9th day of January 1934, and the 16th day of May 1934, setting forth the fact of payment of the awards, adjudicated in said judgments, into the custody of this court, (by the payment over thereof to the Treasurer of the State of Virginia in the form and manner prescribed in the Public Park Condemnation Act.

Whereupon it was shown to the Court and the Court so finds that an award of one dollar was thus paid over to the Treasurer of the State of Virginia and is held by him subject to the order of this Court, for the taking of the fee simple estate in a certain strip or parcel of land one hundred feet wide designated in the first of said orders as the "Skyline Road Strip" running over or through the lands condemned in the first of said judgments, subject to the rights of way and easements theretofore acquired therein by the United States of America; and that a like award of one dollar was paid over to the said Treasurer and is held by him subject to the order of this Court, for the taking of the fee simple estate in a certain strip or parcel of land one hundred feet wide designated in the second of said orders as the "Skyline Road Strip" running over or through the lands condemned in the second of said judgments, subject to the rights of way and easements theretofore acquired therein by the United States of America, and that the amount of said awards, to-wit, one dollar each, <sup>totaling \$2.00</sup> are now held by the said Treasurer of Virginia in a special account and subject to the order of this Court: that since the date of the payments over of said awards to the Treasurer of Virginia as aforesaid, no person or persons have appeared to claim the said awards, and that there are good grounds for belief that a more or less prolonged period of time may elapse before any person or persons entitled to said awards will appear or lay claim thereto, and before any order can be entered directing the payment of said awards to the person or persons entitled thereto.

Upon consideration whereof the Court is of opinion that it should order and direct, and, upon the motion of Counsel for the Petitioner, the Court doth hereby order and direct:-

(a) That the Treasurer of the State of Virginia pay over to the General Receiver of this Court the sum of one dollar held by him as aforesaid in special account for the payment of the award of one dollar for the taking of the parcel or strip of land one hundred feet wide designated in the first above mentioned order as the "Skyline Road Strip": and a further sum of one dollar held by him in like form and manner and designated in the second above mentioned order as the "Skyline Road Strip": and that payments of said amounts may be made by the issuance of separate checks, drafts, or money orders for one dollar each, payable to the "General Receiver of the Circuit Court of Rockingham County," showing respectively that the said checks, or drafts or money orders, are issued for "Skyline Road Strip" award, under order of the Circuit Court of Rockingham County entered the 27 day of November 1936, which checks, drafts or money orders shall be transmitted to said General Receiver through the Clerk of this the Circuit Court of Rockingham County, who is directed as and when he receives the said checks, drafts or money orders, to turn over the same to the General Receiver of this Court upon his execution of the proper receipt therefor to the Treasurer of the State of Virginia, which receipt the said Clerk is further directed to transmit forthwith upon its execution to the said Treasurer of Virginia.

(b) That the General Receiver of this Court may and shall accept, take over and conserve the amounts of the above mentioned awards, as and when the same are turned over to him by the Treasurer of Virginia under and pursuant to this order, and that said General Receiver hold the same subject to the order of this Court:

(c) That the Clerk of this Court shall execute and deliver, forthwith, to the Treasurer of Virginia, and the General Receiver of this Court duly certified copies of this order as and when the same is entered herein, and that such certified copies of this order shall constitute full authority to the said Treasurer of Virginia and the said General Receiver of this Court for all and every lawful act or acts done by them in complying with its terms.
