

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE 25 day of July in the year of our Lord 1838 Between

John Weather one of the Overseer of the Poor of the Western District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Jacob Dundove of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the sixteenth day of April in the year 1838 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Zachariah Hain ^{son of Colow} of the age of 3 years on the 12 Day of March last years to be an Apprentice with him the said Jacob Dundove and as an Apprentice with him the said Jacob Dundove to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Zachariah Hain shall arrive, and come to the age of twenty one years, according to the Act of the General-Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during

all which time and term the said Zachariah Hain shall the said Jacob Dundove well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Zachariah Hain shall be put unto by his said Master according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said Zachariah Hain and the said Zachariah Hain honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said Jacob Dundove

and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said Jacob Dundove And the said Jacob Dundove for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of ~~the Farming & Gardening~~ which he the said Jacob Dundove now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,

or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Jacob Dundove shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the the term aforesaid: ~~And also that the said~~

~~Jacob Dundove shall teach, or cause to be taught, the said Zachariah Hain Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three~~ and will moreover pay to the said Zachariah Hain the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
