

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE

Sixth day of *June*

in the year of our Lord 183/

Between *John Bowman*

one of the Overseer of the Poor of the

1st

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and

Levi May

of

the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid bearing date the *January* day of *Court*

in the year 183/ has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Diana Vance*

of the age of *Six* years *Novem* 1st years 1830

to be an Apprentice with him the said *Levi May*

and as an Apprentice with him the said *Levi May* to dwell from the

date of these presents, until the said *Diana Vance* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Eighteen* years, according to the Act of the General

Assembly in that case made and provided For and during all which time and term the said *Dianna Vance*

shall the said *Levi May*

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Dianna Vance*

shall be put unto by his said *Levi May*

according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Dianna Vance* and the said *Dianna Vance*

honestly and obediently in all things be-

have towards the said *Levi May*

and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Levi May*

And the

said *Levi May* for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the

Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *House Wifery* which

he the said *Levi May* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform, or cause to be taught, instructed and

informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said *Levi May* shall also find and allow unto the said

Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

Levi May shall teach, or cause to be taught to the said *Dianna Vance* Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the

Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Dianna Vance* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
