bind himself to the said Williams or his Successor
Overseer of the poor to teach or instruct or cause
to be taught the said boy the art and mystery of
Weavers trade within the term above mentioned
and to furnish the said apprentice with Cloase
Meat drinke and lodging fit and convenient for such
an apprentice and to teach or cause him to be taught
to read and write and common arithmatick includ-
ing the Rule of three and at the end of his appren-
ticeship shall give unto the said apprentice all
such freedom dues as the law shall direct
