

**This Indenture** MADE THE *Twentieth* day of *November*

in the year of our Lord 1840 Between *Jacob Rohr Sr.*

one of the Overseer's of the Poor of the *First* District in the County of Rockingham of the one part, and *Peachey Rice* of the other part witnesseth, that the said Overseers of the Poor by virtue of

an Order of the County aforesaid bearing date the *October* ~~day of~~ *Court* in the year 1840 has

placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind *Peter Montague* of the age of *Thirteen* years to be an Apprentice with him the said *Peachey Rice* and as an Apprentice

with him the said *Peachey Rice* to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said

*be on the*

*Peter Montague* shall arrive, and come to the age of *Twentyone* years, according <sup>*which will*</sup> to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided. For and during all which time and term the said

*Peter Montague* shall the said *Peachey Rice*

well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said *Peter Montague* shall be put unto

by his said *Master* according to the Power, Wit and Ability of the said *Peter Montague* and

the said *Peter Montague* shall honestly and obediently in all things behave towards the said *Peachey*

*Rice* and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family of him the said *Peachey Rice*

And the said *Peachey Rice* for himself, heirs Executors and Administrators doth hereby

promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor in office for the time being, that the said

Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of *the Cabinet business* which he the said

*Peachey Rice* now useth, after the best manner that he can, or may teach, instruct, and inform,

or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth, or in any wise appertaineth, and that the said

*Peachey Rice* shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, apparel,

washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet, for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said

*Peachey Rice* shall teach, or cause to be taught to the *said Peter Montague*

Reading, Writing and Common Arithmetic including the Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said *Peter*

*Montague* the Sum of *Twenty* Dollars at the Expiration of the aforesaid Term.
