## INDENTURE MADE THE Swentell day of Decomber in the year of our Lord 1823 Between Philip Roonts District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Permenas Woods of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the County aforesaid 37.0 day of November Court in the year 1823 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind John Moods poor boy of 14 year the 15th may labst years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Termenas Hoads and as an Apprentice with him the said to dwell from the date of these presents, Permenas Woods until the said John Moods shall arrive and come to the age of Twenty one years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said Yohn Woods shall the said Wermen as his said Master well and faithfushall be put unto by Permenas well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said John according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him the said John honestly and obediently in all things behave towards Lis of the said Permenas Washer and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family And the said Permenas Moods for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Young which he the said Dermenas Macde now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Permenas Moods shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient meat, drink, appearel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said Permenas Woods shall teach or cause to be taught to the said John Woods Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said John.
