PURSUANT to the provisions of Section 8, of Chapter 410 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Virginia, Session of 1928, (Public Park Condemnation Act) and pursuant to Section 29 of said Act, George H. Levi of Clarke County, Virginia, W. L. Green of Shenandoah County, Virginia and Miller A. Price of Shenandoah County, Virginia, are appointed special investigators, and members of a board of Appraisal Commissioners; each of said appointees having the citizenship and residential qualifications required by said Act; and said appointees are directed to qualify as such special investigators and members of a board of Appraisal Commissioners, by taking an oath before the Clerk of this Court to maintain and support the Constitution of the United States of America, the Constitution of the State of Virginia, and for the faithful and impartial discharge of their duties as such special investigators and members of a Board of Appraisal Commissioners.

AND PURSUANT to section 23 of the aforesaid Act, each of said appointees upon his qualification as such special investigator and as such member of a Board of Appraisal Commissioners, or in either or both of said capacities, is clothed with like right, powers and obligations and duties as those conferred by law upon the Sheriff of Rockingham County, Virginia, with relationship to the execution within said Rockingham County, of any and all orders entered by the Court or the Judge thereof, in these proceedings, including the service and return of process and the service or posting of any and all notices and the return thereof.
