



Whereas Evelyn Shinners was this day found guilty before me, J. B. Hager Mayor ex off a justice of said county, of a misdemeanor, for this, that he, the said Evelyn Shinners, on the 26th day of August, 1912, in said county, was put in jail and held for action of the Grand Jury

, and I, the said justice, adjudged that he should pay a fine of dollars and cents, for the said offence, and dollars and cents, the cost of prosecution; and the said , being so convicted, and being now required by me to pay the said fine and costs, has not paid the same, but wholly failed to do so.

These are, therefore, in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia, to command you, the said constable, to take the said Evelyn Shinners, and convey him to the jail of said county, and there deliver him to the keeper thereof, together with this warrant; and to command you, the keeper of the said jail, to receive the said Evelyn Shinners into your custody in the said jail, and him there safely keep, until he shall have paid said fine and costs, or until he be otherwise discharged by law.

[For the collection of a fine and costs, a justice may either—(1) commit to jail, as in above form, or (2) take security for payment of same within 30 days, for which purpose an endorsement on the warrant, with date, of the name of the surety and the amount, is sufficient; or (3) merely certify the fine and costs to the clerk of the circuit court, who firsts issue a fl. fa., and, if it proves ineffectual, then a capias—see Code, sec's 717-18, amended, Acts 1899-1900, p. 544, and Acts 1902-4, p. 605, and sec's 719, 727. In case surety is given, add to the judgment the following: "And... thereupon acknowledged himself as surety for the said.....for the payment of said fine and costs, to the clerk of the circuit court of said county, within thirty days from date hereof." 
