

THIS INDENTURE MADE THE 19th day of January

in the year of our Lord 1824 Between Samuel Bowman an Overseer of the Poor of the District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and John Wampler

of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid baring date ~~the~~ December day of Court in the year 1823

has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Samuel Brown a poor boy ~~is~~ aged 15 years the 15th of June 1823, to be an Apprentice with him the said John Wampler

and as an Apprentice with him the said John Wampler to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Samuel Brown shall arrive and come to the age of twenty one

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said Samuel Brown shall the said John Wampler his said

Master well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Samuel Brown shall be put unto by the said John Wampler according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him

the said Samuel Brown and shall honestly and obediently in all things behave towards him the said John Wampler and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said John Wampler And the said John Wampler for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his

Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a Farmer which he the said John Wampler now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach,

instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said John Wampler shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparel, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And also that the said John Wampler shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Samuel Brown

Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said Samuel Brown the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the

aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
