Whereas has this day made complaint and information on oath before me, J. H. DOWNING, Mayor of said City, that... *Clyde Armstrong* on the *7th* day of *June* 191*6*

in said city, did... *unlawfully cause a breach of the peace and was drunk and disorderly*

..... in violation of an ordinance of the said City:

These are therefore in the name of the Commonwealth of Virginia to command you forthwith to apprehend and bring before me, or some other Justice, the bod *y* of the said.....
