

THIS INDENTURE

MADE THE 30th day of July 1823 Between Norton Gunn Guardian of Jacob Bryan ^{and with the consent of his said Ward} Overseer of the Poor of the

District in the County of Rockingham of the one part and Jacob Goust of the other part, witnesseth, that the said Overseer of the Poor aforesaid by virtue of an Order of the Court of the County aforesaid

barring date the 4th day of February in the year 1823 has placed and bound and by these presents doth place and bind Jacob Bryan of the age of Seventeen years, to be an Apprentice with him the said Jacob Goust

and as an Apprentice with him the said Jacob Goust to dwell from the date of these presents, until the said Jacob Bryan shall arrive and come to the age of Twenty one years

years, according to the Act of the General Assembly in that case made and provided, by and during all which time and term the said Pastor Jacob Bryan shall the said Jacob Goust well and faithfully serve in all such lawful Business as the said Jacob Bryan

shall be put unto by Jacob Goust according to the Power, Wit and Ability of him the said Jacob Bryan honestly and obediently in all things behave towards him and honestly and orderly towards the rest of the Family

of the said Jacob Goust And the said Jacob Goust Norton Gunn Guardian for himself his Executors and Administrators doth hereby promise and covenant to and with the said Overseer of the Poor and his Successor for the time being, that the said Apprentice shall in the Craft, Mystery and Occupation of a House Joiner

which he the said Jacob Goust now useth, after the best manner that he can or may teach, instruct and inform or cause to be taught, instructed and informed, as much as thereunto belongeth or in any wise appertaineth, and that he the said Jacob Goust shall also find and allow unto the said Apprentice sufficient

meat, drink, apparell, washing, lodging, and all other things needful or meet for an Apprentice during the term aforesaid: And and the said Jacob Goust shall teach or cause to be taught to the said Give to the said Reading, Writing, and Common Arithmetic including the Single Rule of Three, and will moreover pay to the said

Jacob Bryan the Sum of Twenty Dollars at the Expiration of the and six months schooling during the term aforesaid aforesaid Term. IN WITNESS whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year above written.
