The grand jurors in and for the body of said county of Rockingham and now attending said Court at its February term, 1927, upon their oaths do present that Victoria Davis, who was heretofore on the 13th day of November, 1923, convicted of violating the Prohibition laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, in the Circuit Court of Rockingham County, Virginia, and who then and there was sentenced to pay a fine of fifty dollars and to serve for a period of thirty days in jail, did, within one year next prior to the finding of this indictment, in the said county of Rockingham, unlawfully and feloniously have in her possession a still, still cap, worm, tub, fermenter, and other appliances connected with and used in the operation of a still, without having the same registered as required by law, against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This indictment is found on the testimony of W. T. Rexrode, D. H. Dofflemyer, and George A. Lawson, witnesses sworn in Court and sent before the grand jury to give evidence.
